# 1. Brief

### 1.1. Purpose

BeatDAO is a 'Creative Public Good' project, which means that the purpose of the DAO is strictly focused on empowering its members with any resources they need to create music or art, improve their living situation, collaborate and network, and access education.

### 1.2. Vision

The main vision of the DAO is to operate in symbiosis with particular 'Autonomous Contributors' (further called 'Agents') in order to constantly bring value to the DAO for its members.

### 1.3. Members

BeatDAO associates music producers, fans, and DAO supporters from all around the world.

# 2. Governance

The DAO consists of five groups with a hierarchy in the following order: Operating Committee, Council, Plugins, Donors, and Collectors. Each group has its own permissions and responsibilities.

## 2.1. Operating Committee

The decisive voice in key matters of the DAO. Full permissions, including the permission to change the 'DAO Configuration' or 'DAO Policy' on-chain. The group quorum is set at 100%. The group's responsibilities include participation in polls both on-chain and off-chain, and taking part in shaping

the future of the DAO by acting in good faith for the benefit of the DAO. The committee consists of the Council and Plugins:

#### 2.2. Council

A group of 'Agents' contributing autonomously and in symbiosis towards the general benefit of the BeatDAO members. The group has all permissions except the permission to change the 'DAO Configuration' or 'DAO Policy' on-chain and vote on 'poll' type proposals. The group quorum is set at 51%. Each agent has their own circles for which they are responsible:

- **2.2.1.** beatdao.near: DAO Manager Agent
  - 2.2.1.1. Circles of responsibility: On-chain voting, usage of <u>NEAR's</u>

    available tools to keep the DAO self-sustainable, and researching potential new self-sustainability models, link hub (see 1.5.), YouTube Channel.
- **2.2.2.** wizzow.near: IRL Marketing Agent
  - **2.2.2.1. Circles of responsibility**: On-chain voting, onboarding artists, presence at web3 conferences, and researching potential real-life benefits for DAO members.
- **2.2.3. fatokunmayowa.near**: Community Agent
  - 2.2.3.1. **Circles of responsibility**: On-chain voting, keeping the BeatDAO community engaged by organizing online initiatives and keeping the members active on-chain by usage of <u>NEAR's available tools</u>.
- **2.2.4. skthealternator.near**: Web2 Agent
  - 2.2.4.1. **Circles of responsibility**: On-chain voting, content creation on TikTok focused on the DAO, music production, and initiatives, and management of X, Instagram and BeatStars.

## 2.3. Plugins

A group of proven music producers, spread around the world. The group has limited permissions, as they can only cast votes on on-chain polls and submit

the following types of proposals: 'transfer', 'poll', and 'function\_call'. The group quorum is set at 51%. Plugins are the main beneficiaries of the DAO.

### 2.4. Donors

A group of supporters using a quadratic funding model. The group has very limited permissions, as they can only vote on one type of proposal—'polls'. The group quorum is set at 100%.

### 2.5. Collectors

A group of DAO enthusiasts and Plugins fans, interacting with the DAO's content and initiatives. The group has very limited permissions, as they can only vote on one type of proposal—'polls'. The group quorum is set at 75%.

### **2.6.** Members Maintenance

The Operating Committee has the right to remove the Council of the DAO if they fail to meet the requirements of their role. The DAO has the right to remove its members if their wallets have been inactive for at least three months or if a member, or the group of members act in bad faith.
